

Dear Texas High School Counselor:

Subject: 2016 TTA Foundation Scholarship Application and Guidelines

The Texas Telephone Association Foundation (TTAF), a non-profit, philanthropic organization founded to help further the understanding of telephony and advance telecommunications as a career choice, will award six, four-year scholarships, in the amount of \$1,500 per year to students entering college for the 2016-2017 school year.

Through March 18, 2016, the TTA Foundation will accept applications for scholarships to be granted beginning Fall 2016. It is our intention to fully review every application submitted. Therefore, TTA Foundation will accept a maximum of two qualified applications per high school counselor. (For example, if your school has three counselors, you may submit a total of six applications.) The Scholarship Committee will make its selections from those applications which meet the following criteria and include the required materials:

- ♦ U.S. Citizen;
- Student graduating from a Texas high school no later than June 2016;
- ♦ Student achieving a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher (out of a possible 4.0);
- ♦ Student planning to attend a **Texas college or university** by the Fall of 2016;
- ♦ A completed application postmarked no later than March 18, 2016, including a current transcript
- A letter of acceptance from a Texas college or university where student has been accepted.
- Copy of student's SAR (Student Aid Report).

Please note--special consideration will be given to students who will be pursuing a college degree in fields of study which are of particular interest to telecommunications (such as math, business, education, technology, engineering, and computer science, etc.). The courses of study in high school, extra-curricular/civic activities and demonstrated leadership will also be considered. In addition, special consideration will be given to students who have established financial need.

By late April, the TTA Foundation Scholarship Committee will select six (6) finalists to receive four-year scholarships in the amount of \$1500 per year.

Scholarship recipients will be notified by early May.
