To Schedule Your Exam Go To:

- WWW.VICTORIACOLLEGE.EDU/TESTINGCENTER: Choose "TSI Assessment" from the left hand side > Register Today > Enter Username and Password> Watch video > Answer Practice Questions
- APPOINTMENT PLUS FIRST TIME USERS: Create an account. The username and password you create will be used for future appointments. Please do not create more than one profile.
- SCHEDULING AN EXAM: Select Exam from the drop down box (be careful to choose correct testing site) > Select a date from the list > Click Continue > Enter billing information > Enter credit card information > Click continue to process and schedule appointment

• Valid/Current Photo ID is **required** to test.

- <u>Do not</u> bring personal belongings into the center. (Personal Calculators are not allowed on this exam)

The **TSI Assessment** is the test that you will take if you are **Non-Exempt** in reading, writing, and/or mathematics. The results of this test will determine:

- Whether you will be <u>required</u> to participate in developmental education classes,
- The areas of academic deficiencies that need to be addressed in developmental education classes,
- Your placement in the specific developmental education classes that will best meet your instructional needs,
- A diagnostic profile of your specific academic deficiencies so that you can target those areas for the fastest improvement track.

As you can see, it is <u>so very important</u> that you perform your very best on the **TSI Assessment.**

TSI Assessment College-Readiness Cut-Score Ranges:

Mathematics	350	
Reading	351	
Writing	5 on Essay	At least 350 AND essay score of at least a 5; OR At least 363 AND essay score of at least a 4; OR LESS THAN 350 AND an ABE Diagnostic at least a 4 AND essay of at least a 5

What to Expect:

- Three academic areas: Mathematics, Reading and Writing
- The placement score will be used to determine the type of developmental education that would best serve your particular needs.
- The diagnostic score may also be used for placement purposes, but the results of this test also reveal those strengths and weaknesses that should be addressed in your individual developmental plan.
